



Sustainability Crowdsourced Conversation Update

The CHGT is busy at work exploring and developing actions on the following topics discussed at the forum on Apr 27, 2022

1- Develop the framework for a Cleveland Heights Climate Action Plan

The CHGT has organized a Collaborative Climate Action Planning working group that will co-create a high-level outline of key components for a city level climate action plan, including areas of focus drawn from GHG emissions accounting (ex: energy, transportation, food/agriculture) as well as cross-cutting themes that address the impacts of CAP plan implementation – racial, gender and social equity, economic vitality, health, and wellness.

The working group is composed of local experts in the Sustainability space. The group will be meeting and working together throughout the summer with the final goal of outlining a recommended process and methodology for its development in partnership with Mayor Seren's team as well as a timeline for its adoption and implementation.

First meeting May 28, 2022

2- Address littering concerns

The CHGT will be reaching out to local groups to discuss the possibility of developing a grassroots anti-littering campaign

Outreach to begin in June 2022 - more details to come

3- Develop a pathway for inclusion

Initiate organic conversations with underrepresented neighborhoods to identify their priorities related to their relationship with the environment and collaborate on a path forward.

First outreach effort will take place during LovingKindness Week, working on a green space beautification project in the Caledonia neighborhood in partnership with Caledonia Community Cultural Arts and Start Right Church
