

CC'23 - Building Community with Renters & Landlords Small Group Discussion Questions

ICE BREAKER (10 min): Share your name, the neighborhood where you live, if you are a renter or a homeowner. On a scale of 1-5, how would you rate your sense of belonging in the Heights?

INVESTMENT vs BELONGING (25 min): 54.4% of all survey respondents rated their *investment* in the Heights a 5 while only 33.3% rated their *sense of belonging* a 5. Why do you think the numbers are so starkly different? Do you feel this way? What steps do you think you could take to increase a sense of belonging in your own neighborhood?

• In case your group needs clarity: *Investment* refers to what an individual feels they give to the community while sense of belonging is how welcome they feel in the community (i.e. what they get back)

US vs THEM (25 min): Both renter and homeowner respondents identified the top reason they have chosen the Heights as their home because of shared community values (54.9% of renters; 57% of homeowners). Even so, the Heights seems to have an "us vs. them" when it comes to homeowners and renters/landlords. Where do you think that divide comes from? What kinds of actions could you take to minimize that divide and focus more on building a connected neighborhood, regardless of renter/homeowner status?
